

Catalog SOP: How to Download Restock Inventory Report in Seller Central




Who is this for? Amazon sellers who want to manage their inventory more effectively by monitoring restock inventory levels.



Objective: The objective of this guide is to provide step-by-step instructions on how to download a restock inventory report in Amazon Seller Central.

1. Go to the "Inventory" tab on the top menu of Seller Central and select "FBA Inventory".



2. From this page, you can click the "Restock Inventory" from the Inventory drop down.
