Overview

Sellercloud allows you to remove products you no longer wish to use by deleting them from your inventory. Alternatively, you can mark such products as [Inactive](#). This will hide them from default inventory searches instead of removing them completely.

You can only **delete SKUs** that have no related inventory, orders, listings, or other product relations, for example, [Shadow Products](#), [N-Matrix](#), or [Kits](#). However, if an SKU has an established history in the system, we recommend marking them as **Inactive** instead.

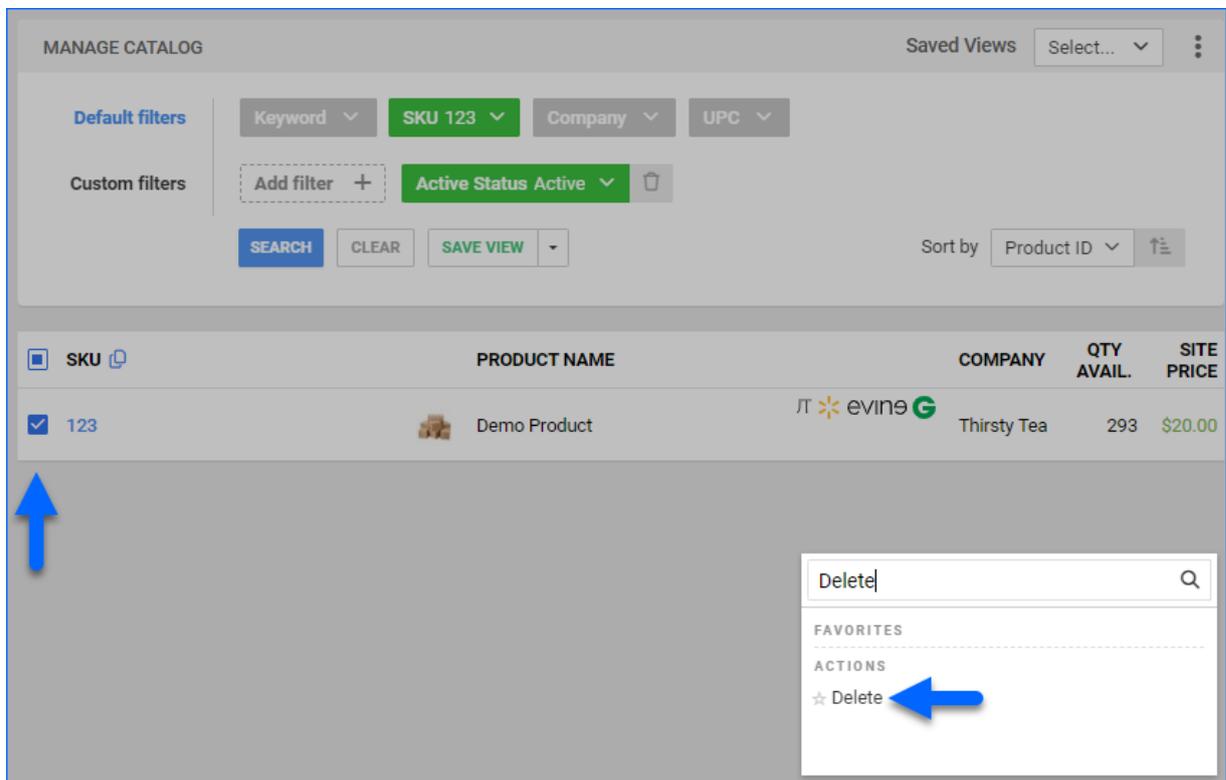
Delete a Product

You can delete products individually or in bulk.

Individually

To delete a single product, navigate to:

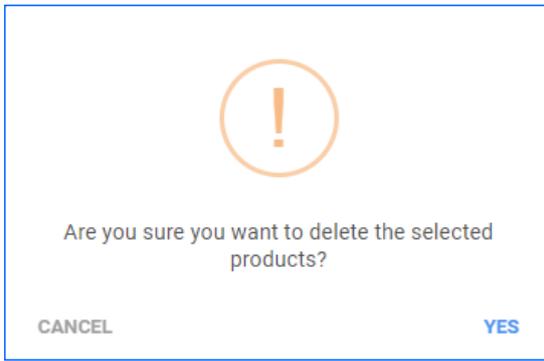
1. [Catalog](#) > [Manage Catalog](#).
2. From this page, select one or more products.
3. [Action menu](#) > [Delete](#).

 - b. **_Action_Confirm_**
4. Specify the appropriate **SKUs**, and enter **DELETE** for each product line within both the **_Action_** and

_Action_Confirm_ columns.
