Overview

Proposition 65, also known as the **Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986**, requires sellers in California to provide clear warnings about potentially harmful chemicals. Therefore, as a seller, you need to include warnings on your listings and ensure your products are properly labeled to comply with these regulations and avoid fines or other legal ramifications.

In this article, you will learn how to add Proposition 65 warnings to ensure that your listings on all integrated channels are compliant.

Add Proposition 65 Warnings

You can add Proposition 65 warnings to products individually or in bulk.

Individually

To add a default warning for all channels to a single product:

1. Go to the [Product Details Page](#).
2. Click **Edit**.
3. In the **Details** panel, check the **Has Proposition 65 Warning** box.
4. Next to the **Proposition 65 Warning Message**, click **Change**.

In Bulk

To add warnings to multiple products at once, [Bulk Update Products](#) using the following column headers in your template:

- **HasProposition65Warning** – Set to **True** to enable the warning.
- **Proposition65WarningMessage** – Enter the desired warning message.
- **HasProposition65WarningLabelOnPackage** – Set to **True** to indicate that the product includes a warning label.

This setting applies only to products sold on Sears and Houzz.

Alternatively, you can use plugins to automatically add Proposition 65 warnings to products based on certain conditions. Open a ticket with [Sellercloud Support](#) to request additional customizations tailored to your workflow. Any such modifications are considered billable.
